

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Important Safety Information



Read this section thoroughly before using the product. Please ensure you observe the safety instructions to avoid accidents, injury and damage.

Intended purpose

The **Welcare Breatheasy Breathing Trainer** is a precision medical Breathing Trainer, designed to open the airways into the lungs that have been partially obstructed over the years, due to natural aging, pollution, poor physical condition, or smoking (if applicable).

Contraindications

Inspiratory muscle training, such as training with a Breathing Trainer, is not for use by individuals with any of the following conditions:

- · Severe cardiovascular, neurological, or musculoskeletal disorders.
- Chronic lung condition (chest or thoracic pain, pneumothorax, chronic thromboembolic pulmonary disease, severe chronic obstructive pulmonary disease, bullae or haemoptysis of unknown origin).
- Respiratory obstruction or severe respiratory pathology.
- · Recent neck or lung surgery.
- Recurrent laryngeal spasm.
- Structural or valve heart disease (i.e. Myocardiopathy, myocarditis, angina, marked elevated left ventricular end-diastolic volume and pressure).
- Uncontrolled hypertension.
- Unstable vital parameters.
- · Pacemaker.
- Marked osteoporosis with a history of rib fractures.
- Lower back pain (severe).
- Ruptured eardrum or any other condition of the ears.

If in doubt, consult your medical advisor.

Safety Warnings

- DO NOT let children to play with the Breathing Trainer it is not a toy.
- The Breathing Trainer is **NOT** suitable for children under 6 years.
- This product is **NOT** intended for use by children without adult supervision.
- This product is **NOT** intended for use by persons (including children) with limited physical, sensory or mental abilities or lacking experience and/or knowledge, unless they are supervised by a person responsible for their safety or have received and understand the instructions/safety warnings for use of the product from this person in advance.
- **DO NOT** use this product for anything other than its intended purpose and only use as described in this manual.
- This Breathing Trainer is for single patient use only.
- This device is designed for exercising your inspiratory muscles only.
 No other use is intended or implied.
- Consult your healthcare professional before using the Welcare Breatheasy Breathing Trainer.
- This Breathing Trainer is not intended to diagnose, treat, cure, or prevent any disease.
- Whilst training with this Breathing Trainer you should feel resistance when inhaling but it should not be painful. If you feel pain whilst using this Breathing Trainer, stop immediately and consult your doctor.
- Some users may experience slight ear discomfort when training with this Breathing Trainer, especially if they are recovering from a cold. This is caused by inadequate equalisation of pressure between the mouth and ears. If symptoms persist, please consult your doctor.
- If you are suffering from a cold, sinusitis, or respiratory tract infection, we advise that you do not use the Breathing Trainer until symptoms have disappeared. If in doubt, consult your doctor.


Important Safety Information - continued

- Refer to your medical advisor before using this device if you have a history of any of the following conditions:
 - Oxygen therapy (long-term).
 - Beta-blocker medication.
 - Endocrine abnormalities or diseases.
 - Clinically present hypoxemia.
 - Ischemic heart disease.
 - Atrial fibrillation.
 - Heart failure.
 - Back pain (moderate).
 - Autoimmune or inflammatory disease.
 - Desaturation during or following Inspiratory Muscle Training (IMT) <94%.

Cautions

- DO NOT drop or put heavy objects on the Breathing Trainer.
- **DO NOT** expose to temperatures over 40°C.
- DO NOT turn the indicator below value zero (0).
- Clean with a damp soft cloth and mild detergent if required.
- DO NOT use any harsh chemical cleaning agents. Dry with a soft cloth.
- Keep the Breathing Trainer and its components out of reach of children.
- · Keep children away from the packaging material.
- Check the device for signs of damage prior to use.
- Ensure that all components are fitted securely prior to use.
- **DO NOT** use the device if there are visible signs of damage.

Training Resistance Levels



WBT-01

LOW Resistance – Suitable for rehabilitation of lung function for people with certain respiratory illness, or children over the age of 6 years old wanting to strengthen and improve overall lung function.

• <87 cmH₂O



WBT-02

MEDIUM Resistance – Suitable for healthy people and people recovering from certain respiratory illness aiming to improve their overall health and wellbeing, including past smokers.

<177 cmH₂O



WBT-03

ADVANCED Resistance – Suitable for athletes and sporting people who want to improve their overall health and increase lung function and endurance.

• <200 cmH₂O

- Ensure all components are fitted securely prior to use.





Setting up the Welcare Breatheasy Breathing Trainer


- 1. If required, connect the Lanyard to the Breathing Trainer. (Figure 1)
- Turn the Bottom Cover clockwise or counterclockwise to choose the desired resistance. You can see the indicator in the clear view window move up or down. (Figure 2)
- 3. Attach the Nose Clip to your nose. (Figure 3)
- 4. Connect the Mouthpiece securely to the Breathing Trainer. (Figure 4)







Note: Do not turn the indicator below value zero (0).



Using the Welcare Breatheasy Breathing Trainer

- Sit in an upright position or stand up straight.
- The resistance must be set to level 0 for the first time.
- **DO NOT** increase the resistance level if you develop signs or symptoms of severe dyspnoea, fatigue, or unstable vital signs.
- Place the Mouthpiece between your lips.
- Inhale quickly and deeply.
- Exhale slowly.
- Try to complete 30 breaths in a row (30 breaths is recommended but Doctors advice should always be followed).
 - Gradually increase the resistance level if you can easily do 30 breaths at a time.
 - Turn the resistance adjustment clockwise to increase the resistance level, then repeat.


Note: Most people see improvements after 4 weeks.

- It is recommended to exercise 30 times in the morning, and 30 times at night, daily.
- If you feel fatigue or tired during exercise, please rest before continuing.
- Precautions from harmful exercise must be considered in the first few weeks of use.

Replacing the Filter

- Remove the Bottom Cover. This can be done by pinching it between your finger and thumb then sliding away. Do not turn the Bottom Cover, this will change the resistance but will not remove the cover (Figure 5).
- Remove the old Filter and replace with a new one (Figure 6).
- Replace the Bottom Cover.
- Discard the used Filter.





It is recommended to use your Welcare Breatheasy Breathing Trainer daily. When following this usage guide, it is recommended to change the Filter monthly.

Cleaning and Storage

- · After using the Breathing Trainer:
 - Remove the Nose Clip from the nose.
 - Remove the Mouthpiece from the Breathing Trainer.
 - Wash the Mouthpiece and Nose Clip with mild soapy water then rinse thoroughly with clean water.
 - Allow to air dry or dry with a soft, dust-free cloth.
 - Store the Breathing Trainer, Mouthpiece, and Nose Clip into the Carry Bag provided.
- This cleaning procedure should be followed prior to initial use and thereafter as required.

Note: As the Mouthpiece and Nose Clip will be exposed to saliva and sweat during use, please do not share the Breathing Trainer.

Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Unable to take a breath in	The resistance is too high	Turn the Bottom Cover anticlockwise to lower the resistance
Unable to breathe out with ease	The Exhale Valve is obstructed	Ensure the Exhale Valve is unobstructed


